2. Why were these verses significant to you? What did these verses teach you about God and/or yourself?

3. As we studied the pastoral epistles (1&2 Timothy, Titus) we were presented with many theological truths and life lessons. Create a short list of 2 or 3 theological truths and/or life lessons you have either learned for the first time or been reminded of from your study of 1&2 Timothy and Titus and record the verses where each is addressed.

*An example of a theological truth would be: God is truth and cannot lie (Tit. 1:2).*

*An example of a life lesson would be: Faithful believers should expect suffering (2 Tim 3:12)*

4. How has your study of the pastoral epistles affected one area of your life? Be specific.

5. How can what you have learned be used to bring and give God glory?

6. As summer approaches, how are you planning to continue spending consistent, quality time in God’s Word? Ask God to help you identify where you need to grow in your faith. Write out a plan, but make it attainable. Being accountable to someone often helps us to be faithful God’s calling. Find someone who will hold you accountable and share your plan with them.
